


# Sony Remote

Replaces Sony RMT-DSLR2 & RMT-DSLR1



# Identifying the Parts:



#### otes:

• For the first time use, please pull out the plastic separator at the battery holder.

## Replacing the Battery:

 With the remote control facing down slide the battery tray out of the bottom of the remote.





Remove the old battery and insert a new one by placing it into the insert in the battery tray. Make sure the side marked " + " is facing up. Now slide the tray into the remote so it locks into place.





#### Using the remote with your camera:

- Set your camera's DRIVE MODE to REMOTE CDR. Or locate REMOTE CTRL in your camera's menu and turn it ON. Refer to your camera's instruction manual for more specifics.
- 2. Press the S button on the remote to take a photograph.
- 3. Press the 2S button to take a photograph after a 2 second delay.
- 4. Press the Start/Stop button to begin or end a video recording.
- 5. Press the + or button to zoom in or zoom out the lens. This function will only work with a Sony power zoom lens.
- \* Note: not all buttons may work the same on all cameras. Functionality can vary by camera model.

# Using the remote with your television:

- First connect your camera to your television or monitor using the proper cable. Refer to your camera's instruction manual for more specifics.
- 2. Many of the remote's buttons will look similar to and function the same as buttons on the back of your camera.
- Press the DISP button to toggle through different display options on your camera.
- 4. Press the Playback button to review your images.
- 5. Press the Slide show button to start or stop a slide show. During a slide show you can:
- Use the Left and Right arrow buttons to see the previous or next image
- Use the Enter button to pause or resume playing the slide show
- Use the Delete button followed by the Arrow buttons and Enter button to delete an image.
- \* Note: not all buttons may work the same on all cameras.

#### Using the remote with your pictbridge printer:

- Connect your camera to a Pictbridge compatible printer. You
  may be able to connect to a printer simultaneously to connecting to a television or external monitor for easier viewing. Refer
  to your camera's instruction manual for more specifics.
- Display the image you want to print on the camera's LCD display and/or on your television while connected.
- 3. Press the PRINT button on the remote.
- For more details about printing, refer to your camera's instruction manual.
