Travel Adapter

Please refer to the 5 figures on this instruction sheet which demonstrate the various, possible positions for the ProMaster Travel Adapter's receptacle connectors. Locate the country in which you are using the Travel Adapter and then position the connectors accordingly.

Pay special attention to the pop-out support frame shown in figure 5 which helps increase contact and stability with using certain recessed outlet receptacles. The support frame is accessed by sliding the two blue switches on the sides of the adapter down. When you are finished using the support frame be sure to slide the two blue switches up as you press the frame back into its storage position.

The two USB ports are dynamic in the sense that they will auto-detect the electrical draw of a device you connect to either of them. The output of the ports will adjust to your device's needs automatically. The maximum output for either USB port is 2.4A. The maximum output for both USB ports when used simultaneously is 3.4A. This means you can use a high-draw device (such as a tablet) in one port at 2.4A while the other port is charging a low-draw device at 1.0A. If you connect two high-draw devices at the same time the Travel Adapter will not be able to charge both at 2.4A at the same time due to its 3.4A combined max. output. Therefore it will adjust the output of both USB ports down to remain within its 3.4A limit. Both high-draw devices will charge slightly slower than if only one was connected to the Travel Adapter at a time, in this case.

This travel adapter allows you to connect your devices to various types of AC receptacles in many countries. It adapts to the outlet but it does not convert voltage (the two USB ports are an exception and will provide proper voltage for USB-A type connections). Be sure to check the input voltage of the device you are using is compatible with the output voltage of the AC receptacle you intend to use before connecting to it. A safety fuse is installed within this travel adapter to reduce the risk of overloading your device. A spare fuse is also included. The fuse can be accessed by opening the round, blue cover on the back of the travel adapter. Use a small coin to turn the cover counterclockwise and then remove it to access the fuse. Replace it in reverse order.
